

On March 9, 1970, WMA Transit Company (WMA) filed its WMATC Tariff No. 31 setting forth new increased fares to be effective April 9, 1970. By Order No. 1026, issued March 13, 1970, we suspended the revised Tariff No. 31 and set formal hearings to determine if the increased fares would be just and reasonable. The suspension of Order No. 1026 expires today. Inasmuch as we have not completed our deliberation, it will be necessary to suspend the tariffs for a further seven day period.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that WMATC Tariff No. 31 of the WMA Transit Company, filed on March 9, 1970, and suspended by our Order No. 1026 through June 10, 1970, be, and it is hereby, further suspended through June 17, 1970.
