On June 22, 1970, A. B. & W. Transit Company (A.B. & W.) filed its WMATC Tariff No. 40 setting forth a new schedule of interstate fares to be applicable to a completely revamped system of fare zones.

By Order No. 1063, served July 9, 1970, we suspended that proposed tariff and set a public hearing to determine whether the fares contained therein complied with the standards of the Compact. The hearing was opened on July 27, 1970 and was recessed on July 28 until a date to be established after consultation among the Commissioners.


THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED:

1. That the hearing in Docket 221 will be reconvened for the purpose of the completion of applicant's case on Tuesday, August 25, 1970, at 9:30 A.M. in the hearing room of the Commission, 1625 I Street, N.W., Washington, D.C.

2. That staff and protestant testimony be distributed to all parties by September 8, 1970 with the exception that testimony relating to the origin and destination study undertaken by the Mt. Vernon Council of Citizen Associations may be submitted to the parties as late as September 14, 1970.

3. That the hearing will reconvene on Monday, September 21, 1970 at 9:30 A.M., in the hearing room of the Commission, 1625 I Street, N.W., Washington, D.C., for the purpose of cross examination of staff and protestant witnesses.
