On July 24, 1970, D. C. Transit System, Inc., filed an application for reconsideration of our Order No. 1052 asserting that the Commission had committed several errors in reaching its conclusion in that order. Transit alleged errors in the use of the ridership projections which were presented by the company, in failing to use the charter revenue estimates of the company, in failing to establish the injuries and damages reserve at \$2,250,000 as requested by the company, in failing to allow the amortization of an alleged deficiency in the reserve for injuries and damages, and in failing to increase the Minibus fare from 10¢ to 20¢.

We will deny Transit's application for reconsideration. All of the contentions raised were fully discussed in Order No. 1052 and no new reasons for reaching different conclusions have been presented by Transit in its application for reconsideration.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that the Application for Reconsideration of Order No. 1052 filed by D. C. Transit System, Inc., be, and it is hereby, denied.
