On April 16, 1970, Greyhound Airport Service, Inc. (Airport Service), filed Application No. 620 requesting permission to increase its existing taxicab fares between Washington National and Dulles International Airports and points within the Washington Metropolitan District.


Order No. 1040, issued May 8, 1970, set the matter for public hearing, and on July 20, 1970, Order No. 1069 was issued which permitted applicant to devise a fare structure under which its taxicab operations would break even, to be effective on an interim basis pending consideration of the rate structures of applicant's taxicab, limousine and bus operations. Airport Service duly submitted an interim fare proposal which was adopted on July 29, 1970 by Order No. 1075.

Prior to the interim determination of Application No. 620, Airport Service submitted its WMATC Tariff No. 12 replacing its WMATC Tariff 11, which would increase its other charges for transportation within the Metropolitan District. That document has been numbered Application No. 643. We shall hold further public hearings so that Applications 620 and 643 can be considered together and a consistent rate structure be established for all Airport Service operations.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED:

1. That a public hearing be held on Monday, September 28, 1970 at 10:00 A.M., in the hearing room of the Commission, 1625 I Street, N.W., Washington, D.C., on Applications 620 and 643, which shall be combined as Docket No. 217.
2. That Greyhound Airport Service Tariff No. 12 be, and it is hereby, suspended effective August 12, 1970 through November 10, 1970.
3. That Greyhound Airport Service publish notices of the proposed increases and the hearings thereon in a newspaper of general circulation in the Metropolitan District no later than 25 days before the hearing date.
4. That interested persons desiring to be heard on this matter shall so indicate, in writing, to the Commission with a copy to applicant's attorney, L. C. Major, Esq., 421 King Street, Alexandria, Virginia, at least 10 days prior to said hearing.
