On June 26, 1970, we issued Order No. 1052 which authorized D. C. Transit System, Inc., to file new tariffs increasing some of its fares. On July 27, 1970, John M. Cleary, pro se, filed an application for reconsideration of that order.

Commission Regulation 28-03 provides that failure to act on an application for reconsideration within 30 days after it is filed shall be deemed a denial of the application. Today is the 30th day from the date John M. Cleary's application was filed and the Commission has not yet determined what action it will take on the application. We have therefore requested, and have received, Mr. Cleary's concurrence in the extension of the 30-day automatic denial to 45 days from the date his application was filed.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that for purposes of our consideration of the application for reconsideration of Order No. 1052 filed by John M. Cleary, the 30-day period in Regulation 28-03 be, and it is hereby, extended to 45 days.
