On November 3, 1970, WMA Transit Company (WMA) filed its WMATC Tariff No. 32 setting forth new increased regular route fares to be effective December 3, 1970. By Order Number 1107 issued December 2, 1970, we suspended that tariff pending investigation and public hearings thereon. That order set hearings to begin on Monday, December 28, 1970. We now find it necessary to postpone the commencement of those hearings for one day.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED:

1. That the hearing on this matter scheduled for Monday, December 28, 1970, be, and it is hereby, rescheduled for Tuesday, December 29, 1970, at 10:00 a.m. in the hearing room of the Commission, Room 314, 1625 I Street, N.W., Washington, D. C.

2. That WMA Transit Company post notice in its buses advising the public of the new hearing time.

3. That WMA Transit Company publish one notice of the hearing in a newspaper of general circulation in the Metropolitan District, and another in a newspaper published and circulated in Prince George's County, Maryland, once, at least 10 days prior to December 29, 1970.
