On November 27, 1970, D. C. Transit System, Inc. (Transit) filed Application No. 663 to combine and extend its Routes J5, N2, and N4. By Order No. 1112, we set a public hearing for January 6, 1971, to consider issues raised by the application.

At the hearing an alternate proposal was made by the Commission staff and agreed to by Transit. However, we asked that the company and the staff supply additional information so that we might have a better record for determining some of the issues before us. Since that hearing, additional information has been provided, and some members of the public interested in this application have requested that further hearings be held.


We believe that a further hearing session is appropriate.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED:

1. That a public hearing in this matter be held on March 30, 1971, at 10:00 a.m. in the hearing room of the Commission, Room 314, 1625 Eye Street, N.W., Washington, D. C.
2. That D. C. Transit System, Inc. post notice of the time and place of the above hearing on all buses operating over the affected routes.

3. That D. C. Transit System, Inc. publish notice of the above hearing in a newspaper of general circulation in the Metropolitan District once, not less than 10 days prior to March 30, 1971.
