On January 26, 1972, D. C. Transit System, Inc. (Transit) filed Application No. 757 requesting permission decrease service on its Cabin John Line, Route 20.

On weekdays, Transit proposes to discontinue service after 7:38 p.m., rather than the present 1:03 a.m. discontinuance, and to reduce the frequency of service at other times. On Saturdays, Transit proposes to begin service at 8:25 a.m., rather than the present 6:25 a.m. starting time, and to discontinue service after 4:11 p.m., rather than the present 11:03 p.m. ending time. On Sundays, Transit proposes to discontinue all service.

As part of its application, Transit filed revised timetables bearing the proposed effective date of February 28, 1972. The Commission has received timely written protests to the proposed change in schedules, and will exercise its option to suspend the proposed effective date, pending a public hearing to determine whether the schedule changes should be approved.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED:


1. That the proposed effective date of the schedule change proposed by D. C. Transit System, Inc., for its Cabin John Line, Route 20, be, and it is hereby, suspended.

2. That this matter be, and it is hereby, scheduled for public hearing on Tuesday, March 28, 1972, at 10:00 A.M. in the Hearing Room of the Commission, Room 314, 1625 Eye Street, N. W., Washington, D. C. 20006.

3. That D. C. Transit System, Inc., post notice of the subject, time, and place of the public hearing in all of its buses operating over the affected route not later than Friday, March 3, 1972.

4. That D. C. Transit System, Inc., publish notice of the application and public hearing in a newspaper of general circulation in the metropolitan area on or before Friday, March 3, 1972.
