The Commission deals herein with Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity No. 11 issued to Alexandria, Barcroft and Washington Transit Company (A. B. & W.), of Alexandria, Virginia.

This matter came before the Commission upon its own motion pursuant to Order No. 1249. That order posited that, in view of the takeover of certain transit services by the Washington Metropolitan Area Transit Authority (WMATA), it was necessary to amend the outstanding certificates of those carriers whose operations were assumed. A. B. & W. is such a carrier.

A pre-hearing conference was held on April 3, 1973, and a pre-hearing order, Order No. 1253, was issued. That order defined the issues relating to A. B. & W. as follows:

(A) What is the impact on Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity No. 11 of the purchase of the properties of A. B. & W. by WMATA?

(B) How should Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity No. 11 be revised?


The hearing was held as scheduled on May 3, 1973. At that time a joint stipulation between A. B. & W. and WMATA

was offered and received into evidence. In brief, the joint stipulation stated that WMATA had taken over the entire operation of A. B. & W. on February 4, 1973, pursuant to an agreement of sale. It further stated that it was the intention of the parties that the takeover would include all operating rights issued by the Washington Metropolitan Area Transit Commission to A. B. & W. as set out and evidenced by Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity No. 11 which was purchased by WMATA. It was further jointly stipulated that A. B. & W. had ceased to operate as a carrier since February 4, 1973. The parties acknowledged that the operations performed by WMATA are exempt from regulation by the Washington Metropolitan Area Transit Commission.

The Commission believes that the joint request by WMATA and A. B. & W. to cancel Certificate No. 11 should be granted.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity No. 11 issued to Alexandria, Barcroft and Washington Transit Company be, and it is hereby, revoked in its entirety.
