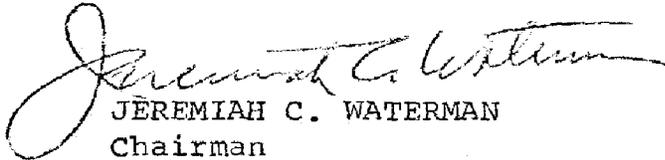
The Washington Metropolitan Area Transit Regulation Compact, Title II, Article XII, Section 5(e) states in pertinent part that each tariff "shall state a date on which the new tariff shall take effect, and such date shall be at least thirty (30) days after the date on which the tariff is filed, unless the Commission by order authorizes its taking effect on an earlier date." By letter and proposed tariff dated June 22, 1973, as subsequently amended, D. C. Transit System, Inc. (Transit) petitions the Commission for permission to amend its WMATC Tariff No. 45 by accepting Supplement No. 1 to be effective July 1, 1973.

Supplement No. 1 seeks to add "Tour No. 10a", which, Transit states, includes all the features of "Tour No. 10" as well as a cruise on the Potomac River with dinner and beverages provided by Le Bateau of Virginia, Inc. The two hour dinner cruise will begin at 11:00 P.M. following the sightseeing tour. The proceeds to Transit from "Tour No. 10a" will be the same as from "Tour No. 10", with the balance of the charge for the new tour representing Le Bateau's charge for the dinner cruise.

Transit and Le Bateau entered into the underlying agreement for this new tour on June 22, 1973. It was therefore not possible for Transit to file its tariff on the usual thirty (30) day effective notice unless it delayed operation of this tour until well into the peak summer period. We see no reason why this tour should not earlier be made available to the traditionally heavy summer tourist trade.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that Supplement No. 1 to WMATC  
Tariff No. 45 of D. C. Transit System, Inc., be, and it is  
hereby, authorized to become effective July 1, 1973, on less  
than thirty (30) days notice.
