Approval of Taxicab Fares) Application No. 820

By petition filed November 28, 1973, Airway Ground Transportation Services, Inc. (Airway Ground), sought approval of certain specified taxicab fares for service between the Washington Airports ^{1/} and points in the Metropolitan District.

By Order No. 1294, served December 28, 1973, the Commission suspended the proposed taxicab fares, initiated an investigation of their propriety, and required Airway Ground to provide certain information.

Since issuing that order, the Commission has neither received the required information nor had any indication from Airway Ground that it intends to pursue its application. Accordingly, it is the opinion of the Commission that Application No. 820 should be dismissed.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that Application No. 820 of Airway Ground Transportation Services, Inc., be, and it is hereby, dismissed.
