By Order No. 1310, served March 18, 1974, the proposed modification to the tariff of Blue Lines, Inc., to be effective March 25, 1974, was suspended for a period of 90 days through June 23, 1974, unless otherwise ordered. A public hearing was scheduled to commence April 9, 1974. Counsel for Blue Lines filed on March 25, 1974, a motion for continuance of the hearing date to May 1, 1974. Counsel submits as the basis for the request to postpone the hearing that he will be unavailable on April 9, 1974, due to a prior commitment. It appears that granting the motion will not jeopardize the public interest in this matter.

Pursuant to the provisions of Rule of Practice 7-06, the requested continuance shall be granted.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED:

1. That the motion by counsel for Blue Lines, Inc., for continuance of hearing date be, and it is hereby, granted.

2. That the public hearing scheduled for Tuesday, April 9, 1974, by Order No. 1310, served March 18, 1974, be, and it is hereby, postponed until Wednesday, May 1, 1974, at 10:00 a.m., in the Hearing Room of the Commission, Room 314, 1625 Eye Street, N. W., Washington, D. C. 20006.

3. That applicant post, in the form prescribed by the staff of the Commission, notice of the application and hearing in each of its vehicles no later than Wednesday, April 3, 1974.


4. That applicant publish, in the form prescribed by the staff of the Commission, notice of the application and hearing in a newspaper of general circulation in the Metropolitan District no later than Wednesday, April 3, 1974.

5. That six (6) copies of the direct evidence on behalf of Blue Lines, Inc., shall be submitted to the Commission and one copy served on each party of record, no later than Wednesday, April 24, 1974.

6. That any person desiring to be heard on this matter shall notify the Commission, in writing, on or before Monday, April 22, 1974, and mail a copy of such notification to counsel of record for Blue Lines, Inc., Leonard A. Jaskiewicz, Esquire, 1730 M Street, N. W., Suite 501, Washington, D. C. 20036.

7. That the portions of Order No. 1310, served March 18, 1974, not inconsistent with this order be, and they are hereby, incorporated herein.
