By Order No. 1362, served October 18, 1974, Application No. 810 of Yellow Cab Company, doing business as All States Limousine Service (All States) for a certificate of public convenience and necessity was scheduled for public hearing to commence Thursday, November 21, 1974.

All States seeks authority to transport aircraft crews having a prior or subsequent movement by air between Dulles International Airport or Washington National Airport, on the one hand, and on the other, points located within the District of Columbia. Application No. 810 indicates that the proposed service would involve transportation of passengers for hire under a continuing written contract for the furnishing of transportation services through the provision of a vehicle or vehicles to meet the distinct need and for the exclusive and periodically recurrent use of Northwest Air Lines, Inc.

On November 8, 1974, counsel for All States filed a petition to amend Application No. 810 to include transportation service under a contract with Delta Air Lines (Delta). The petition also requests that the public hearing on the amended application be scheduled for December 11, 1974.

As justification for the requested amendment, counsel for All States submits that service for Delta was not contemplated at the time that Application No. 810 was filed. The request to postpone the date for public hearing on the amended application is based on the procedural requirement that the public be notified of the amended application. It appears that granting the petition will not jeopardize the public interest in this matter.

Order No. 1362 contained ordering paragraphs requiring All States to publish notice of the application and public hearing and directing All States to submit certain specified statements and exhibits. In addition to those exhibits, All States shall be required to submit a copy of the contract between All States and Delta which forms the basis for the requested amendment of Application No. 810. All States also shall be prepared to present representatives of Delta who are able to support any claim that public convenience and necessity require such service.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED:

1. That the petition to amend application and reassignment of oral hearing filed by Yellow Cab Company, doing business as All States Limousine Service, be, and it is hereby, granted.

2. That Application No. 810 of Yellow Cab Company, doing business as All States Limousine Service, be, and it is hereby, amended to embrace charter operation pursuant to contract with either Delta Air Lines or Northwest Air Lines, Inc.

3. That the public hearing scheduled for Thursday, November 21, 1974, by Order No. 1362, served October 18, 1974, be, and it is hereby, postponed until Wednesday, December 11, 1974, at 10:00 a.m., in the Hearing Room of the Commission, Room 314, 1625 Eye Street, N. W., Washington, D. C. 20006.

4. That Yellow Cab Company, doing business as All States Limousine, publish notice in the form prescribed by the staff of the Commission of the amended application and postponed hearing in the same newspaper in which the notice was published pursuant to Order No. 1362, served October 18, 1974, no later than Saturday, November 23, 1974, and present at the hearing certificates of publication from the selected newspaper.

5. That the six (6) copies of the statements and exhibits that Yellow Cab Company, doing business as All States Limousine, was required to submit by Order No. 1362, served October 18, 1974, together with a copy of the contract between applicant and Delta Air Lines, be submitted to the Commission and one copy served on each party of record on or before Monday, November 25, 1974.

6. That any person desiring to protest shall file a protest or any person desiring to be heard on this matter shall notify the Commission,

in writing, on or before Monday, December 2, 1974, and mail a copy of the protest or notification to counsel of record for Yellow Cab Company, doing business as All States Limousine, S. Harrison Kahn, Esquire, Suite 733 Investment Building, Washington, D. C. 20005.
