Order No. 1364, served October 18, 1974, among other things, scheduled Application No. 824 of Executive Limousine Service, Inc., (Executive) for public hearing on November 26, 1974, required Executive to publish notice of its application and hearing in a newspaper, and required certain statements and exhibits to be submitted by November 19, 1974.

On November 18, 1974, Executive filed "Petition to Postpone Hearing and Amend Application" 1/ requesting that its application "to operate as a contract carrier in the transportation of airline crews and employees under continuing contract with Air France, British Overseas Airways Corporation, 2/ and Delta Air Lines, Inc." be amended to add "Trans World Airlines, Inc., Aeroflot-Soviet Airlines and Ground Services, Inc., the latter as agent on behalf of a number of scheduled and non-scheduled airlines".

Executive requests the date for filing statements and exhibits be changed to December 2, 1974, and the date of the public hearing be changed to December 9, 1974. Executive

acknowledges that republication of the newspaper notice may be appropriate.

Executive has decided to amend Application No. 824 to include additional authority rather than proceed with the scheduled public hearing on the application as it now stands, with a separate application and hearing for the additional authority.

Accordingly, another public hearing will be scheduled for the amended application, with concomitant changes in the dates for filing statements and exhibits and newspaper publication. However, it is not possible to accommodate the administrative and procedural requirements by the dates suggested by Executive.

Executive shall be required to submit and be prepared to support with competent witnesses the following exhibits:

- (A) A detailed balance sheet of applicant as of September 30, 1974;
- (B) A detailed income statement of applicant for the 12-month period ending September 30, 1974;
- (C) A projected statement of revenues and expenses, including taxes, for a one-year period, together with supporting details, including operating ratio;
- (D) Copies of the individual contracts between Executive and Air France, British Airways, Delta Air Lines, Inc., Trans World Airlines, Inc., Aeroflot-Soviet Airlines and Ground Services, Inc., which form the bases for the proposed services;
- (E) A tariff for each of the proposed services; and
- (F) A list of equipment, including specifications, which will be used to provide the proposed service.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED:


1. That Application No. 824 of Executive Limousine Service, Inc., as amended, be, and it is hereby, rescheduled for public hearing to commence Thursday, January 9, 1975, at 10:00 a.m., in the Hearing Room of the Commission, Room 314, 1625 Eye Street, N. W., Washington, D. C. 20006.

2. That Executive Limousine Service, Inc., publish notice in the form prescribed by the staff of the Commission of such application and hearing in a newspaper of general circulation in the Metropolitan District no later than Friday, December 13, 1974, and present at the hearing a certificate of publication from the selected newspaper.

3. That six (6) copies, the original to be submitted at the hearing, of the statements and exhibits required hereinbefore be submitted by Executive Limousine Service, Inc., to the Commission and one copy served on each party of record on or before Friday, December 13, 1974.

4. That any person desiring to protest or otherwise to be heard on this matter shall notify the Commission, in writing, on or before Monday, December 30, 1974, and mail a copy of such notification to counsel of record for Executive Limousine Service, Inc., Maxwell A. Howell, Esquire, 1511 K Street, N. W., Washington, D. C. 20005.
