

By Order No. 1365, served October 24, 1974, the Commission suspended, effective October 25, 1974 the proposed effective date of a tariff increase proposed by Blue Lines, Inc. The initial suspension terminates after 90 days pursuant to the provisions of the Compact, Title II, Article XII, Section 6(a)(1).

The purpose of this order is to extend the suspension period for an additional 30 days in accordance with the Compact, Title II, Article XII, Section 6(a)(2).

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that the proposed modification to WMATC Tariff No. 3 of Blue Lines, Inc., be, and it is hereby, further suspended through Friday, February 21, 1975, unless otherwise ordered.
