By Order No. 1403, served January 31, 1975, the public hearing scheduled for February 4, 1975 was continued until further order of the Commission. The basis for the continuance was a request by counsel for Ironsides Medical Transportation Company (Ironsides). Counsel for Ironsides sought the continuance so that a permanent authority application could be filed and consolidated with the temporary authority application.

Counsel for Ironsides has neither filed a permanent authority application nor requested hearing on the temporary authority. The grant of temporary authority must be based in part on a finding of "immediate and urgent need". See Compact, Title II, Article XII, Section 4(d)(3). The Commission shall dismiss the application for temporary authority as a result of the lapse of time between the granting of the requested continuance and the date of this order.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that Application No. 817, Docket No. 280 of Ironsides Medical Transportation Company be, and it is hereby, dismissed.
