
The above-captioned application was filed April 14, 1975, by The Colonial Transit Company, Inc. (Colonial). By Order No. 1421, served April 22, 1975, the matter was scheduled for public hearing and Colonial was granted temporary authority to transport employees of the United States Customs Office, Department of the Treasury, between the Charter House Motor Hotel in Alexandria, Virginia, and the U. S. Customs Training Center, Washington, D. C. By Order No. 1429, served May 21, 1975, the public hearing was postponed.

On July 28, 1975, Colonial filed a request to withdraw the application, stating that the transportation, and hence the authority, is no longer required. Colonial's request will be granted.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED:

1. That the obligations imposed upon The Colonial Transit Company, Inc., by Order No. 1421, served April 22, 1975, be, and they are hereby, cancelled.
2. That the temporary authority granted to The Colonial Transit Company, Inc., by Order No. 1421, served April 22, 1975, be, and it is hereby, revoked.
3. That the public hearing scheduled for July 30, 1975, by Order No. 1429, served May 21, 1975, be, and it is hereby, cancelled.
4. That Application No. 860 of The Colonial Transit Company, Inc., be, and it is hereby, dismissed without prejudice.
