Extra Passenger Charge )

By Order No. 1500, issued today, the Commission has revised the extra passenger charge for pre-formed parties in interstate taxicab service provided by taxicabs regulated by the District of Columbia Public Service Commission. 1/ Based upon an analysis of similar intrastate rates applicable within other local licensing jurisdictions within the Metropolitan District, the Commission increased the extra passenger charge from 20¢ to 40¢ for each passenger in excess of one in a pre-formed party.


In accordance with its policy of maintaining a uniform party rate for all interstate taxicab service within the Metropolitan District, the Commission shall increase from 20¢ to 40¢ the extra passenger charge applicable to interstate taxicab service provided by taxicabs licensed and regulated by local jurisdictions in the Metropolitan District other than the District of Columbia. This action will constitute the first amendment of the extra passenger charge for interstate taxicab service since it was promulgated by our Order No. 67, served October 9, 1961.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED:

1. That the extra passenger charge for pre-formed parties applicable to interstate taxicab service within the Metropolitan District provided by taxicabs licensed and regulated by local jurisdictions 2/ within the Metropolitan District shall be forty cents (\$.40) for each passenger in excess of one.

2. That the rate prescribed herein shall become effective 4:00 A. M., Monday, March 1, 1976.
