By Order No. 1518, served March 15, 1976, the Commission scheduled for public hearing to commence April 13, 1976, Application No. 918 of Suburban Transit Company (Suburban) for a certificate of public convenience and necessity authorizing the transportation of passengers, over irregular routes, in special operations, between the Fort Washington-Oxon Hill area of Prince George's County, Maryland, and Washington, D. C., and between the Fort Washington-Oxon Hill area and Crystal City, the Pentagon, and Rosslyn, Virginia. On April 2, 1976, the Washington Metropolitan Area Transit Authority (WMATA) filed a protest to Suburban's Application No. 918 and urged a denial of the application.

On April 8, 1976, Suburban filed a request to have the public hearing postponed. Suburban states that it currently is not prepared to present the evidence required by Order No. 1518. Suburban requests that the public hearing be scheduled for a later date but does not indicate the period for postponement.

Pursuant to the provisions of Rule of Practice 7-06, the public hearing will be postponed until May 10, 1976, and the date for filing the exhibits required by Order No. 1518 will be extended to April 28, 1976.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED:

1. That the request by Suburban Transit Company for a postponement of the public hearing scheduled by Order No. 1518, served March 15, 1976, be, and it is hereby, granted.


2. That the public hearing scheduled by Order No. 1518, served March 15, 1976, to commence April 13, 1976, be, and it is hereby, cancelled.

3. That Application No. 918 of Suburban Transit Company be, and it is hereby, scheduled for public hearing to commence Monday, May 10, 1976, at

10:00 A. M., in the Hearing Room of the Commission, Room 314, 1625 I Street, N. W., Washington, D. C.

4. That Suburban Transit Company file and serve copies of the exhibits, as required by paragraph three of Order No. 1518, served March 15, 1976, on or before Wednesday, April 28, 1976.
