Pursuant to Order No. 1537, served April 16, 1976, as modified by Order No. 1552, served May 4, 1976, and Order No. 1554, served May 7, 1976, a public hearing was held on May 25, 1976, concerning Application No. 933, filed April 7, 1976, by Annette H. Milling trading as Milling Tours (Milling).


Milling's Application No. 933, as described in Order No. 1537, set forth a proposal to render per capita sightseeing service in either a 9-passenger van or an 11-passenger van. At the public hearing, it was developed that Milling also desires authority to perform the proposed service in leased motor coaches. In that the initial Commission order did not state that Milling was proposing to perform the special operations in motor coaches, proper notice has not been given. In order to cure this procedural defect, the Commission shall direct Milling to publish notice in a newspaper of general circulation in the Metropolitan District. The Commission shall permit protest to Application No. 933 to be filed out of time in accordance with provisions set forth hereinafter.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED:

1. That Annette H. Milling trading as Milling Tours publish in a newspaper of general circulation in the Metropolitan District notice of its proposal to render per capita sightseeing in motor coaches, in the form prescribed by the staff of the Commission no later than Friday, June 4, 1976, and file with the Commission forthwith a certificate of publication from the selected newspaper.

2. That any person desiring to protest shall file a protest with the Commission in accordance with Commission Rule 14 on or before Friday, June 18, 1976, and mail a copy of such protest to counsel of record for Annette H. Milling trading as Milling Tours, James W. Lawson, Esquire, 1511 K Street, N. W., Washington, D. C. 20005.
