On May 25, 1976, the Washington Metropolitan Area Transit Authority, (WMATA) a protestant in the above-captioned matter, filed a motion for postponement of the public hearing from June 8, 1976 to June 18, 1976. Good cause having been shown, the motion of WMATA will be granted pursuant to Commission Rule 7-06.


THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED:
