

By Order No. 1570, served June 21, 1976, a further public hearing with respect to Application No. 933, Docket No. 322, of Annette H. Milling trading as Milling Tours (Milling) was scheduled to commence Friday, July 9, 1976. The purposes of the further public hearing are to develop an appropriate record and to afford an opportunity to substantiate with proper evidence the contentions, statements, and submissions of the protestants The Gray Line, Inc., and White House Sightseeing Corporation and to afford an opportunity for Milling to proffer evidence indicating that the public convenience and necessity require the operation of leased motor coaches in the proposed service.

On July 2, 1976, counsel for the protestants requested that the further public hearing be postponed and rescheduled for Wednesday, July 28, 1976. The counsel for the protestants has received the consent of Milling's counsel for the requested postponement. Since the postponement would not be contrary to the public interest, the request will be granted pursuant to Commission Rule 7-06.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that the further public hearing scheduled for July 9, 1976, by Order No. 1570, served June 21, 1976, be, and it is hereby, postponed and rescheduled to commence Wednesday, July 28, 1976, at 9:30 A. M., in the Hearing Room of the Commission, Room 314, 1625 I Street, N. W., Washington, D. C. 20006.
