
On September 20, 1976, Earnest C. Smith trading as S & S Transportation Company (S & S) filed the above-captioned application as more specifically described in Order No. 1609, served September 24, 1976. That order, inter alia, scheduled the application for public hearing on November 1, 1976.

The public hearing was convened at 9:30 A. M. on said date, at which time applicant, through counsel, requested that the application be dismissed inasmuch as applicant had concluded that the proposed operation was not economically feasible. Accordingly, no evidence in support of the application was presented.

The Commission is of the opinion that Application No. 967 should be dismissed without prejudice to applicant filing a new application at a subsequent date. Dismissal of the application will neither prejudice the interest of applicant nor adversely affect the public.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that Application No. 967 of Earnest C. Smith trading as S & S Transportation Company be, and it is hereby, dismissed without prejudice.
