to Revoke Certificate of Public )	Application No. 939
Convenience and Necessity No. 4-A )	Consolidated Docket No. 326

By application filed May 3, 1976, Washington, Virginia and Maryland Coach Company, Inc. (WV&M), seeks revocation of its Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity No. 4-A, pursuant to Title II, Article XII, Section 4(g) of the Compact.

By Order No. 1551, served May 4, 1976, the Commission consolidated Application No. 939 with Application No. 938 of D. C. Transit System, Inc., to revoke Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity No. 5-A. 1/ The Commission also scheduled the consolidated proceeding for public hearing commencing June 1, 1976. Order No. 1551 directed that any person desiring to protest or any person desiring to be heard either file the protest or notify the Commission in writing on or before May 24, 1976. No protests or notices to be heard have been filed or submitted, and no persons appeared at the hearing in opposition to this application.

1/ Subsequently, D. C. Transit System, Inc., filed a motion to withdraw Application No. 938, which motion was granted by Order No. 1564, served June 3, 1976.

The evidence adduced at the hearing shows that WV&M has no equipment and no employees, and that the only operations under Certificate No. 4-A have been conducted by D. C. Transit System, Inc. 2/ Accordingly, the Commission believes that revocation of the certificate is in the public interest.



2. That Certificate No. 4-A, issued June 29, 1973, to Washington, Virginia, and Maryland Coach Company, Inc., be, and it is hereby, revoked.
