By Application No. 986, filed March 11, 1977, Vincent Ferguson Gibson trading as Continental Limousine (Continental) seeks a certificate of public convenience and necessity pursuant to Title II, Article XII, Section 4(b) of the Compact to transport flight crews from Dulles International Airport, Chantilly, Va., to Shoreham Hotel, 2500 Calvert Street, N. W., Washington, D. C., as described in Order No. 1660, served March 15, 1977 and incorporated herein by reference. Public hearing was set to commence Tuesday, April 26, 1977, at 1 p.m. in the Hearing Room of the Commission.

By letter dated April 18, 1977, Continental seeks leave to amend Application No. 986 to include the transportation of flight crews from Gramercy Inn, 1616 Rhode Island Avenue, N. W., Washington, D. C., and the Shoreham Hotel, 2500 Calvert Street, N. W., Washington, D. C. to Dulles International Airport, and return incoming crews to Gramercy Inn and Shoreham Hotel. On April 15, 1977, Executive Limousine Service, Inc., filed its protest to Continental's original Application No. 986.

Continental's motion to amend Application No. 986 will be granted. Since this amendment significantly expands Continental's application the Commission will also postpone the scheduled hearing date and require Continental to publish notice of this amended application.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED:

1. That the Motion of Vincent Ferguson Gibson trading as Continental Limousine to amend Application No. 986 be, and it is hereby, Granted.

2. That the public hearing originally scheduled to commence Tuesday, April 26, 1977, at 1 p.m. be, and it is hereby, rescheduled to commence at 9:30 a.m. on Wednesday, May 25, 1977, in the Hearing Room of the Commission, Room 314, 1625 I Street, N. W., Washington, D. C. 20006.


3. That Vincent Ferguson Gibson post in his vehicles, continuously through the date of the public hearing, notice of this amended application and hearing thereon, in the form prescribed by the staff of the Commission, no later than Monday, May 2, 1977, and present at the hearing a certification of posting.

4. That Vincent Ferguson Gibson publish once, in a newspaper of general circulation in the Metropolitan District, notice of this application and hearing thereon, in the form prescribed by the staff of the Commission, no later than Monday, May 2, 1977, and present at the hearing a certificate of publication from the selected newspaper.

5. That any person desiring to protest the amended application shall file a protest in accordance with Commission Rule 14, or any person desiring to be heard on this matter shall notify the Commission in writing not later than 12 noon, Friday, May 13, 1977 and shall mail a copy of such protest or notice to Vincent Ferguson Gibson, 3123 N. Washington Boulevard, Arlington, Va. 22201.

6. That, except to the extent modified herein, the terms and directives of Order No. 1660, shall continue in full force and effect.
