

By Order No. 1324, served May 1, 1974, and incorporated herein by reference, the Commission, sua sponte, initiated a proceeding pursuant to Title II, Article XII, Section 4(g) of the Compact to determine whether Greyhound Airport Service, Inc. (Greyhound), had failed to comply with the provisions of its certificate of public convenience and necessity by failing to perform transportation within the broad geographical territory described by said certificate. Pursuant to Order No. 1324, a hearing was held on June 4, 1974. No subsequent orders were issued as a result of the hearing. Rather, this matter has remained virtually dormant for the last three years and the evidence adduced at the hearing has become stale. Accordingly, this proceeding will be dismissed without prejudice to the Commission's right to institute a similar proceeding at a later date should it determine such action advisable.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that Docket No. 264, Modification of Greyhound Airport Service, Inc., Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity No. 7, be, and it is hereby, dismissed without prejudice to the Commission's right to institute a similar proceeding at a later date should it determine such action advisable.
