By Order No. 1717, served June 23, 1977, the above-referenced application was scheduled for public hearing to commence August 22, 1977. Any person desiring to protest was directed to file said protest no later than August 12, 1977. No protests were filed.

By motion (petition) filed August 17, 1977, the above-named co-applicants waive their right to an oral hearing, request that the hearing scheduled by Order No. 1717 be cancelled, and seek leave to submit further evidence in the form of verified statements. See Commission Rule 22.

The granting of said motion appears to be in the interests of the parties, would further administrative economy, and is unopposed. Moreover, it appears that the issues herein are capable of being resolved without an oral hearing and cross-examination. Accordingly, the motion will be granted.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED:

1. That the public hearing scheduled to commence August 22, 1977, be, and it is hereby, cancelled.

2. That Rehab Transportation, Inc., and Conval Port Medivan, Inc., be, and they are hereby, directed to file such further evidence as they deem appropriate, in the form of verified statements, no later than Wednesday, September 7, 1977.
