
By Order No. 1760, served October 20, 1977, the above-captioned application was denied for the reason that protestant, Beltway Limousine Service, Inc., held appropriate authority to perform the proposed service, thereby precluding a showing that the second concurrent criterion of Title II, Article XII, Section 4(d)(3) of the Compact had been met.

By application filed November 8, 1977, Bannister Enterprises, Inc. (Bannister), seeks reconsideration of the Commission's decision in Order No. 1760. Bannister's filing consists of a duplicate copy of Application No. 1015 with the notation "Application for Reconsideration of Order No. \_\_\_\_." An undated document which appears to be a proposed service agreement between Bannister and Amtrak is attached, but the document is signed only by Bannister's president and has no probative value.

Inasmuch as Bannister's filing contains no specific assignation of error as required by Title II, Article XII, §16 of the Compact, reconsideration cannot be granted.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that the above-referenced application for reconsideration of Bannister Enterprises, Inc., be, and it is hereby, denied.
