
By Order No. 1735, served August 10, 1977, applicant was directed to file certain exhibits and deposit an assessment with the Commission on or before September 14, 1977. Said order also scheduled a public hearing on the application to commence on September 20, 1977. As of the hearing date, applicant had failed to comply with the Commission's directions and Order No. 1751 was served, cancelling the said public hearing.

Subsequently, applicant moved the Commission to schedule a new hearing date. By Order No. 1758, served October 14, 1977, a public hearing was rescheduled to commence on December 14, 1977. Applicant was further directed to submit six copies of a statement of projected revenues and revenue deductions and the sum of \$200 assessed pursuant to Title II, Article XII, Section 19 of the Compact on or before November 30, 1977. Copies of Order No. 1758 were served on both applicant and its attorney by both first-class and certified mail. Receipts indicating delivery of the certified mailings were received by the Commission on October 19, 1977.

Applicant has failed once again to submit the required filings and assessment in violation of Order No. 1758. Accordingly, Application No. 1009 will be dismissed, with prejudice for a one-year period, for want of proper prosecution.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED That Application No. 1009 of Pickett's Transportation and Van Service, Inc., be, and it is hereby, dismissed with prejudice to the filing of a similar application for a period of one year from the date of service hereof.
