By Order No. 1757, served October 14, 1977, and incorporated herein by reference, the Commission scheduled the above-referenced investigation for public hearing to commence Wednesday, December 14, 1977. Suburban Transit Company (Suburban) subsequently filed a motion (letter) seeking a postponement of said hearing. Suburban alleges that its president will be unable to attend due to a conflicting prior commitment. For good cause shown, the Commission shall postpone the hearing until further order.

By Application Nos. 1027 and 1028, filed November 22, 1977, and December 7, 1977, respectively, Suburban seeks temporary authority and a certificate of public convenience and necessity to perform regular-route operations from points in Montgomery and Prince George's Counties, Md., Rosslyn, Va., and the District of Columbia to the Capital Centre, Largo, Md., and return. Suburban's applications lack detailed descriptions of the proposed routes. Accordingly, Suburban shall be directed to submit detailed route descriptions.


THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED:

1. That Suburban Transit Company's motion to postpone the hearing scheduled for December 14, 1977, be, and it is hereby granted, said hearing to be postponed until further order of the Commission.

2. That Suburban Transit Company be, and it is hereby, directed to file detailed descriptions of the regular routes which are the subjects of Application Nos. 1027 and 1028 no later than Thursday, December 22, 1977.

3. That unless timely compliance is made with the mandate of the last preceding paragraph, Application Nos. 1027 and 1028 shall stand rejected in their entirety effective upon expiration of the said compliance time.
