By Application No. 1030, filed December 20, 1977, Central Delivery Service of Washington, Inc. (Central Delivery), seeks approval pursuant to Title II, Article XII, Section 12(b) of the Compact to transfer by sale its Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity No. 23, issued September 17, 1976, to Yellow Cab of Montgomery County, Inc. (Yellow Cab). Said certificate authorizes charter operations pursuant to contracts with American Airlines, United Airlines and the U. S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission, from and to specified points in the Metropolitan District.

In support of the above-mentioned application, the parties have submitted a bilateral contract of sale, a financial statement of Yellow Cab, an income statement of Yellow Cab for the year ended September 30, 1977, Articles of Incorporation of Yellow Cab and a statement reflecting that all of Yellow Cab's corporate stock and all of Central Delivery's corporate stock is owned by Central Courier Systems, Inc., a Maryland Corporation.

As mandated by the above-mentioned provision of the Compact, a public hearing will be scheduled on Yellow Cab's Application No. 1030.

By Application No. 1031, filed December 20, 1977, Yellow Cab seeks, in conjunction with Application No. 1030, authority to act as a self-insurer pursuant to Commission Regulation 62-05. Yellow Cab asserts that the public interest would be benefited by the granting of this application.

Application No. 1031 shall be scheduled for public hearing on a consolidated basis with Application No. 1030.

Pursuant to Title II, Article XII, Section 19 of the Compact, applicants shall be assessed an amount preliminarily estimated to cover the expense of said hearing.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED:

1. That Application No. 1030 of Central Delivery Service of Washington, Inc., and Application No. 1031 of Yellow Cab of Montgomery County, Inc., be, and they are hereby, scheduled for public hearing to commence Wednesday, March 15, 1978, at 9:30 a.m., in the Hearing Room of the Commission, Room 314, 1625 I Street, N. W., Washington, D. C. 20006.

2. That Yellow Cab of Montgomery County, Inc., be, and it is hereby, designated co-applicant and made a party to Application No. 1030.

3. That Central Delivery Service of Washington, Inc., and Yellow Cab of Montgomery County, Inc., post in each of their vehicles continuously through the date of the public hearing, notice of said applications and hearing thereon in the form prescribed by the staff of the Commission, no later than Friday, February 3, 1978.


4. That Central Delivery Service of Washington, Inc., and Yellow Cab of Montgomery County, Inc., publish once, in a newspaper of general circulation in the Metropolitan District, notice of said applications and hearing thereon in the form prescribed by the staff of the Commission no later than Friday, February 3, 1978.

5. That applicants be, and they are hereby, directed to produce at said hearing, affidavits of said publication and posting.

6. That any person desiring to protest either or both of said applications shall file a protest in accordance with Commission Rule 14, or any person desiring to be heard on these matters shall notify the Commission, in writing, on or before Friday, February 24, 1978, and shall mail a copy of such protest or notice to Jeremy S. Kahn, Esquire, Kahn and Kahn, Suite 733, Investment Building, 1511 K Street, N. W., Washington, D. C. 20005.

7. That applicants be, and they are hereby, assessed \$300 pursuant to the provisions of the Compact, Title II, Article XII, Section 19, and directed to deliver said amount to the office of the Commission, Suite 316, 1625 I Street, N. W., Washington, D. C. 20006, on or before 12 noon, Friday, March 3, 1978.
