By application filed January 3, 1978, McMichael School Bus Service, Inc. (McMichael), seeks a certificate of public convenience and necessity pursuant to Title II, Article XII, Section 4(b) of the Compact to transport, in charter operations pursuant to contract, agents of the United States Custom Service, between the Quality Inn, 1190 Court House Road, Arlington, Va., and the United States Customs Service Academy, 3520 Prospect Street, N. W., Washington, D. C. McMichael now holds corresponding temporary authority pursuant to Order No. 1768, served November 11, 1977.

Title II, Article XII, Section 4(b) of the Compact provides that an application for a certificate of public convenience and necessity may be granted "after hearing held upon reasonable notice." Accordingly, the Commission shall schedule a public hearing on the matter. Applicant will be required to file a statement of projected revenues and revenue deductions and will be assessed an amount preliminarily estimated to cover the cost of the hearing in accordance with Title II, Article XII, Section 19 of the Compact.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED:

1. That Case No. AP-78-1, an application of McMichael School Bus Service, Inc., for a certificate of public convenience and necessity, be, and it is hereby, scheduled for public hearing to commence Thursday, February 16, 1978, at 9:30 a.m., in the Hearing Room of the Commission, Room 314, 1625 I Street, N. W. Washington, D. C. 20006.

2. That McMichael School Bus Service, Inc., be, and it is hereby, directed to publish once, in a newspaper of general circulation in the Metropolitan District, notice of said application and the hearing thereon, in the form prescribed by the staff of the Commission, no later than Tuesday, January 17, 1978.

3. That McMichael School Bus Service, Inc., be, and it is hereby, directed to post in each of its vehicles, continuously through the date of the public hearing, notice of said application and hearing in the form prescribed by the staff of the Commission no later than Tuesday, January 17, 1978.


4. That McMichael School Bus Service, Inc., be, and it is hereby, directed to produce at said hearing affidavits of said publication and posting.

5. That any person desiring to protest shall file a protest in accordance with Commission Rule 14, or any person desiring to be heard in this matter shall so notify the Commission, in writing, no later than Monday, January 30, 1978, and shall mail a copy of such protest or notice to counsel of record for applicant, Philip N. Margolius, Esquire, 1120 Connecticut Avenue, N. W., Washington, D. C. 20036.

6. That McMichael School Bus Service, Inc., be, and it is hereby, directed to file with the Commission six copies of a projected revenue and revenue deductions statement for the proposed service, the original to be produced at the above-scheduled public hearing, no later than 12 noon, Thursday, February 2, 1978.

7. That McMichael School Bus Service, Inc., be, and it is hereby, assessed \$250 pursuant to Title II, Article XII, Section 19 of the Compact, and directed to deliver said amount to the office of the Commission, Suite 316, 1625 I Street, N. W., Washington, D. C. no later than 12 noon, Thursday, February 2, 1978.
