

By Order No. 1715, served July 23, 1977, the above-captioned proceeding was instituted to determine if Reston Commuter Bus, Inc. (RCB), should be ordered to cease and desist from conducting certain transportation operations in alleged violation of Title II, Article XII, Section 4(a) of the Compact.

Subsequently, judicial proceedings were commenced in Civil Action No. 77-602-A before the United States District Court for the Eastern District of Virginia (Alexandria Division). On January 27, 1978, judgment in that proceeding was entered "permanently and perpetually" enjoining RCB pursuant to the provisions of the Compact from engaging in or performing transportation for hire of persons between any points in the Metropolitan District unless and until there is in force an appropriate certificate of public convenience and necessity therefor. Entry of said judgment effectively renders moot the above-captioned proceeding.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that the proceedings instituted in Docket No. 384 be, and they are hereby, discontinued.
