By application filed April 19, 1978, Muhsin David Katib ("Katib" or "applicant") seeks a certificate of public convenience and necessity to transport passengers, together with mail, express and baggage in the same vehicle, in special operations between the International Inn, 10 Thomas Circle, N. W., Washington, D. C., and Washington National Airport, Gravelly Point, Va.

Katib, a sole proprietor, proposes to operate the service in a 1977 "Minibus" seating 10 passengers in addition to the driver. The proposed one-way fare is \$3 per person, and the service would depart the International Inn at one-hour intervals between 8:15 a.m. and 2:15 p.m., inclusive. Passengers would be picked up at the airport only at the request of the International Inn for its guests.

In support of the application, Katib submitted a balance sheet bearing the name "Atlantic Limousine Service", apparently a trade name of applicant. Applicant also submitted letters of support from officials of the International Inn. Finally, applicant submitted an invoice for insurance premiums, although this instrument did not show the limits of liability, the vehicle(s) covered, or the type of operations insured.

Pursuant to the requirements of the Compact, Title II, Article XII, Section 4(b), this application must be scheduled for public hearing. Applicant shall be required to publish notice in a newspaper and post it in his vehicle, and will be assessed a sum preliminarily estimated to cover the cost of the proceeding as required by the Compact, Title II, Article XII, Section 19. In addition applicant will be required to submit a detailed projection of revenues and expenses for the proposed operation for a one-year period.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED:

1. That the above-captioned application of Muhsin David Katib is scheduled for public hearing to commence at 1:30 p.m., Tuesday, June 6, 1978, in the Hearing Room of the Commission, Room 314, 1625 I Street, N. W., Washington, D. C. 20006.

2. That Muhsin David Katib publish once in a newspaper of general circulation in the Metropolitan District notice of this application and hearing in the form prescribed by the staff of the Commission, no later than Friday, May 5, 1978.

3. That Muhsin David Katib post in his vehicle, continuously through the date of the public hearing, notice of said application and hearing in the form prescribed by the staff of the Commission no later than Friday, May 5, 1978.


4. That Muhsin David Katib produce at the hearing affidavits of publication and posting.

5. That any person desiring to protest shall file a protest in accordance with Commission Rule 14, or any person desiring to be heard in this matter shall so notify the Commission, in writing, no later than Thursday, May 25, 1978, and shall mail a copy of said protest or notice to counsel for applicant, Theodore Kligman, Esquire, 503 D Street, N. W., Washington, D. C. 20001.

6. That Muhsin David Katib file with the Commission six copies of a projected revenue and revenue deductions statement for the proposed service, the original to be produced at the above-scheduled public hearing, no later than 12 noon, Friday, May 26, 1978, and to serve a copy thereof on each party of record as of Thursday, May 25, 1978.

7. That Muhsin David Katib is assessed \$250 pursuant to Title II, Article XII, Section 19 of the Compact, and directed to deliver said amount to the office of the Commission, Suite 316, 1625 I Street, N. W., Washington, D. C. 20006, no later than 12 noon, Friday, May 26, 1978.
