

Columbia Transpo Company, Inc., holds Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity No. 19, issued April 28, 1976, authorizing the transportation of passengers in charter operations, sightseeing or pleasure tours, between points in the District of Columbia and the City of Alexandria and the Counties of Arlington and Fairfax, Va., restricted to transportation in vehicles with a designed seating capacity of not more than 15 passengers excluding the driver.

On May 12, 1978, Columbia Transpo requested revocation of this certificate. It does not appear that granting this request would have any adverse impact on the public interest in light of the large number of certificated carriers performing similar services. Pursuant to the authority of Title II, Article XII, Section 4(g) of the Compact, the request shall be granted.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity No. 19 is hereby revoked.
