Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity No. 40, as reissued September 8, 1977, authorizes Edwards Trucking Company, Inc., inter alia, to conduct charter operations pursuant to a contract or contracts with the United States Nuclear Regulatory Commission, transporting employees of the United States government and persons traveling on official government business, together with mail, between the facilities of the NRC at 1717 H Street, N. W., Washington, D. C., and the facilities of the NRC at 7920 Norfolk Avenue, Bethesda, Md.

Edwards' WMATC Tariff No. 3 includes a contract requiring Edwards to provide such service through June 30, 1978. No notice of extension, termination or any other modification to this contract has been filed with the Commission. On July 5, 1978, Beltway Limousine Service, Inc. filed its WMATC Tariff No. 4, Supplement No. 1, covering the operations described above and including a contract between Beltway and the NRC effective July 1, 1978, through June 30, 1979. Accordingly, it appears that Edwards may be remiss in its duties (a) pursuant to Title II, Article XII, §3 of the Compact, Certificate No. 40 and the rules, regulations and orders of the Commission requiring a carrier to furnish the transportation authorized by its certificate and (b) pursuant to Certificate No. 40 which requires Edwards to provide written notice to the Commission within five days of the termination of any contract.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED:


1. That the above-captioned proceeding is hereby instituted pursuant to Title II, Article XII, §4(g) of the Compact for the purposes (a) of determining whether Edwards Trucking Company, Inc., is in compliance with the provisions of the Compact, including Title II, Article XII, §3 thereof, its Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity No. 40, and the rules, regulations and orders of the Commission, and (b) of determining whether said Certificate No. 40 should be revoked to the extent, if any, said carrier is found not to be in compliance.

2. That Edwards Trucking Company, Inc., is hereby made a party respondent to the proceeding.

3. That a public hearing on this proceeding is hereby scheduled to commence Monday, August 14, 1978, at 9:30 a.m., in the hearing room of the Commission, Room 314, 1625 I Street, N. W., Washington, D. C. 20006.

4. That Edwards Trucking Company, Inc., is hereby assessed the sum of \$200 to cover the costs which it is required to bear pursuant to Title II, Article XII, Section 19 of the Compact and is directed to deliver said sum to the office of the Commission, Suite 316, 1625 I Street, N. W., Washington, D. C. 20006, no later than 12 noon, Monday, August 7, 1978.
