
By Order No. 1880, served September 13, 1978, Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity No. 31 of Ironsides Medical Transportation Corporation was suspended for failure to file an appropriate certificate of insurance. An investigation of the matter was instituted, and Ironsides was directed, inter alia, to file the required certificate of insurance.

On September 14, 1978, a proper certificate of insurance was filed with the Commission.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED:

1. That Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity No. 31, issued to Ironsides Medical Transportation Corporation, be, and it is hereby, reinstated, effective this date.
2. That the investigation of Ironsides Medical Transportation Corporation, instituted by Order No. 1880, served September 13, 1978, be, and it is hereby, terminated.
