

By Order No. 1892, served September 29, 1978, as modified by Order No. 1897, served October 3, 1978, the Commission suspended WMATC Tariff No. 3, Supplement No. 2 of Central Delivery Service of Washington, Inc. (Central). A public hearing on the matter has been scheduled to commence on Wednesday, November 15, 1978, and Central has been directed to take certain actions in anticipation of said hearing, including service of notice and the prefiling of certain exhibits. On October 5, 1978, Central tendered for filing an application for reconsideration of said orders.

The Compact, Title II, Article XII, §16, provides, as pertinent that "[a]ny person affected by any final order or decision of the Commission may . . . file with the Commission an application in writing requesting a reconsideration of the matters involved. . . ." In our view, neither above-referenced order constitutes a final order or decision within the meaning of the Compact.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that the application for reconsideration is hereby rejected.
