By Order No. 1924, served November 21, 1978, the Commission granted certain temporary authority to Call-A-Messenger, Inc. (CAM), limited in duration to a period of 30 days. In order to obtain any extension of this temporary authority, CAM was required to submit evidence of its operational and financial fitness, which data has since been received.


Upon review of the data submitted, including the exhibits in Case No. AP-78-53 (in which corresponding permanent authority is sought), the Commission finds that CAM's request for an extension of its temporary authority should be granted.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED.

1. That the temporary authority granted by Order No. 1924, served November 21, 1978, is hereby extended until May 19, 1979, pending further order of the Commission.

2. That in all other respects Order No. 1924 remains in full force and effect.
