
By Order No. 1932, served December 5, 1978, the Commission, inter alia, suspended Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity No. 23 of Central Delivery Service of Washington, Inc. (Central), and instituted an investigation to determine if said certificate should be revoked.

On December 18, 1978, counsel for Central filed a letter which does not challenge the allegations raised in Order No. 1932 and requests that the Commission proceed to revoke Certificate No. 23 without an oral hearing.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED:

1. That Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity No. 23 of Central Delivery Service of Washington, Inc., is hereby revoked.
2. That in all other respects, Case No. MP-78-16 is hereby discontinued.
