Order No. 1950, served January 8, 1979, scheduled the above-captioned matter for public hearing on March 13, 1979, and required, among other things, that Beltway Limousine Service, Inc. (Beltway), post in its vehicles and publish in a newspaper, notice of the application and hearing. On January 26, 1979, counsel for Beltway filed a motion for continuance of the public hearing, advising that the required notice had not been posted or published. The hearing will be rescheduled and dates for posting, publication and protest will also be re-established.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED:

1. That the public hearing in the above-captioned matter is hereby postponed and rescheduled to commence Tuesday, March 13, 1978, at 9:30 a.m., in the hearing room of the Commission, Room 314, 1625 I Street, N. W., Washington, D. C.

2. That Beltway Limousine Service, Inc., post notice of this application and hearing in the form prescribed by the staff of the Commission in each vehicle used in performing the proposed service under temporary authority, conspicuously and continuously through the date of public hearing, no later than Wednesday, February 14, 1979.

3. That Beltway Limousine Service, Inc., publish once in a newspaper of general circulation in the Metropolitan District, notice of this application and hearing in the form prescribed by the staff of the Commission, no later than Wednesday, February 14, 1979.

4. That any person desiring to protest shall file a protest in accordance with Commission Rule 14, or any person desiring to be heard in

this matter shall so notify the Commission, in writing, no later than Wednesday, February 28, 1979, and shall mail a copy of such protest or notification to counsel for applicant, John Miles, Esquire, O'Malley, Miles, Farrington & McCarthy, 9827 Central Avenue, Upper Marlboro, Md. 20870.

5. That in all other respects Order No. 1950, served January 8, 1979, continues in full force.
