On September 22, 1978, Highview Bus Service, Inc. (Highview), filed the above-captioned petition for temporary suspension of its Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity No. 42 which authorizes four specified regular routes, serving no intermediate points, between the Government Printing Office, North Capitol and H Streets, N. W., Washington, D. C., on the one hand, and, on the other, (1) Penn-Mar Shopping Center, District Heights, Md., (2) Woolco Department Store, New Carrollton, Md., (3) Greenbelt Shopping Center, Greenbelt, Md., and (4) Capital Plaza, Lanham, Md.

Subsequent to the filing of this petition, the Commission issued several orders,*/ incorporated by reference herein, dealing with the above-described service. Certain matters were also raised in Civil Action No. 78-2057, Washington Metropolitan Area Transit Commission v. Highview Bus Service, Inc., (D.C. D.C. not printed), a case of which we hereby take official notice. Based on the record in this proceeding and the matters discussed in the above-described orders and judicial proceeding, the Commission is of the view that further processing of this petition requires additional data.


THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED:

1. That Highview Bus Service, Inc., is hereby directed to file with the Commission an original and four copies of a verified statement describing its fitness, willingness and ability to resume the service authorized by Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity No. 42.

2. That Highview Bus Service, Inc., is hereby directed to notify the Commission no later than Friday, May 4, 1979, (a) whether it wishes to prosecute further the above-styled petition, and (b) whether it seeks voluntary revocation of Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity No. 42 pursuant to Title II, Article XII, Section 4(g) of the Compact.
