

By Order No. 1990, served April 26, 1979, Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity No. 32 issued to Bannister Enterprises, Inc., was suspended due to the carrier's failure to maintain evidence of adequate security for the protection of the public. On May 1, 1979, the carrier filed an acceptable certificate of insurance. Accordingly, the suspension imposed by said Order No. 1990 shall be removed.

Certificate No. 32, however, has also been suspended by Order No. 1980, served April 12, 1979, because of the carrier's failure to file its annual report. That suspension and the directive that the carrier cease and desist from engaging in transportation for hire of passengers between points in the Metropolitan District is unaffected by this Order, and is treated as a separate matter in Case No. MP-79-14.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED That the above-referenced suspension mandated by Order No. 1990 is hereby rescinded and the above-captioned proceeding is hereby discontinued.
