
By Order No. 1987, served April 23, 1979, and incorporated herein by reference, the Commission suspended Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity No. 28, issued to Washington Area Mini Bus Tours, Inc. (WAMBT). In violation of the Compact and Commission Regulations, WAMBT has failed to maintain appropriate evidence of insurance coverage.*/ WAMBT was directed within 30 days to file an appropriate certificate of insurance or such other evidence as it deemed pertinent to show good cause why its Certificate No. 28 should not be revoked.

On May 8, 1979, a certificate of insurance was filed naming as the insured "Major Lester Gorham t/a Mini Bus Tours." This certificate covers an individual with a trade name, not WAMBT, a corporation. The Commission's General Counsel called Mr. Gorham the same day that this certificate was received and advised him that it was not acceptable and that a corrected certificate would have to be filed. To date nothing further has been received, and the 30 days for compliance have expired. Accordingly, WAMBT's Certificate No. 28 will be revoked.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED:

That Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity No. 28 of Washington Area Mini Bus Tours, Inc., is hereby revoked pursuant to the Compact, Title II, Article XII, Section 4(g).
