By application filed June 25, 1979, Airport Limo, Inc., seeks a certificate of public convenience and necessity to transport (a) flight crews of Trans World Airlines (TWA) (1) between Washington National Airport, Gravelly Point, Va., and Dulles International Airport, Herndon, Va., via Columbia Island, a point located in the District of Columbia, and (2) between Washington National Airport and Dulles International Airport, on the one hand, and, on the other, hotels located within the Metropolitan District, in charter operations pursuant to contract with TWA, and (b) guests and employees of the Charter House Hotel, Springfield, Va., between the Charter House Hotel and points in the Metropolitan District, pursuant to a contract with the hotel. Service is to be performed with applicant's present fleet of 14 passenger vans; applicant is planning to purchase seven additional vehicles to augment its fleet.

The service for TWA is now being performed by Executive Limousine Service, Inc., under WMATC Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity No. 18. Airport Limo proposes the following rate structure:

Trans World Airlines

Between Washington National Airport and Dulles International Airport	\$25.00
Between Washington National Airport and District of Columbia <u>1/</u>	6.50
Between Dulles International Airport and District of Columbia <u>1/</u>	25.00

In accordance with the requirements of the Compact, Title II, Article XII, Section 4(b), this matter will be scheduled for a public hearing. Airport Limo will be assessed an amount preliminarily estimated to cover the cost of the proceeding and required to submit a current balance sheet and annual projected revenue and revenue deductions statement both for the specific operations proposed herein and for the company's overall existing operations. The data must reflect only Airport

Limo's financial information rather than that of Allstate Messenger and Delivery Service, Inc., applicant's parent company. 2/

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED:

1. That Case No. AP-79-09 is hereby scheduled for public hearing to commence at 9:30 a.m., Tuesday, August 14, 1979, in the Hearing Room of the Commission, Room 314, 1625 I Street, N. W., Washington, D. C. 20006.

2. That applicant publish once in a newspaper of general circulation in the Metropolitan District, notice of this application and hearing in the form prescribed by staff of the Commission no later than Tuesday, July 17, 1979.

3. That applicant post in each of its vehicles, conspicuously and continuously through the date of public hearing, notice of this application and hearing in the form prescribed by the staff of the Commission, no later than Tuesday, July 17, 1979.


4. That applicant produce at the public hearing affidavits of said posting and publication.

5. That any person desiring to protest shall file a protest in accordance with Commission Rule 14, or any person desiring to be heard in this matter shall so notify the Commission, in writing, no later than Wednesday, August 1, 1979, and shall mail a copy of such protest or notification to counsel for applicant, Lawrence D. Levien, Esquire, Akin, Gump, Haver & Feld, Suite 400, 1333 New Hampshire Avenue, N. W., Washington, D. C. 20036.

6. That applicant is assessed \$350 pursuant to Title II, Article XII, Section 19, of the Compact and directed to deliver said amount to the office of the Commission, Suite 316, 1625 I Street, N. W., Washington, D. C. 20006, no later than 12 noon, Tuesday, August 7, 1979.

7. That applicant file with the Commission six copies each of a current balance sheet and projected annual revenue and revenue deductions statement for the proposed service and the overall operations of Airport Limo, Inc., no later than 12 noon, Tuesday, August 7, 1979, and produce the originals thereof at the public hearing.
