By Order No. 2043, served October 9, 1979, the above-captioned proceeding was scheduled for hearing on November 7, 1979. By letter received October 11, 1979, counsel for applicant informed the Commission that he has a prior commitment for the hearing date and requested that the hearing be rescheduled. 
THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED:

1. That the above-referenced public hearing is hereby rescheduled to commence on Tuesday, December 4, 1979, at 9:30 a.m., in the Hearing Room of the Commission, Room 314, 1625 I Street, N. W., Washington, D. C. 20006.
2. That applicant is hereby directed to publish once in a newspaper of general circulation in the Metropolitan District notice of the application and hearing, in the form prescribed by the staff of the Commission, no later than Thursday, November 1, 1979.
3. That applicant produce at the public hearing an affidavit of said publication.
4. That any person desiring to protest the application shall file a protest in accordance with Commission Rule 14, or any person desiring to be heard on this matter shall notify the Commission, in writing, not later than Friday, November 23, 1979, and shall serve a copy of such protest or notification on counsel for applicant, Maxwell A. Howell, Esquire, 1100 Investment Building, 1511 K Street, N. W., Washington, D. C. 20005.

5. That the prior assessment of \$400 made pursuant to Title II, Article XII, Section 19 of the Compact is to be delivered to the office of the Commission, Suite 316, 1625 I Street, N. W., Washington, D. C. 20006, no later than 12 noon, Tuesday, November 27, 1979.

6. That applicant file with the Commission six copies each of a current balance sheet and a current operating statement no later than 12 noon, Tuesday, November 27, 1979, serve one copy thereof on each party of record as of Friday, November 23, 1979, and produce the original at the public hearing.
