The above-captioned applications were scheduled for public hearing on March 25, 1980. See Order No. 2086, served February 29, 1980.

On March 17, 1980, the District of Columbia Department of Transportation filed a formal protest in Case Nos. AP-80-02 and AP-80-03. On March 18, 1980, applicant filed a motion to withdraw those two applications. The applications will be dismissed without prejudice.

On March 17, 1980, Ironsides Medical Transportation Corporation filed a formal protest in Case No. AP-80-04 which seeks a certificate of public convenience and necessity to perform non-emergency transportation of persons confined to wheelchairs between points in the Metropolitan District. On March 18, 1980, applicant filed a motion to postpone the public hearing in Case No. AP-80-04 due to unforeseen circumstances regarding applicant's representation and related matters. A postponement will be granted and the hearing rescheduled.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED:

1. That Case Nos. AP-80-02 and AP-80-03 are hereby dismissed without prejudice at the request of applicant.

2. That the public hearing scheduled in the above-captioned matters for March 25, 1980, is hereby cancelled.


3. That the public hearing on Case No. AP-80-04 is hereby rescheduled to commence at 9:30 A.M., Monday, May 12, 1980, in the Hearing Room of the Commission, Room 314, 1625 I Street, N. W., Washington, D. C. 20006.

4. That applicant is directed to deliver the \$300 assessment made by Order No. 2086 to the office of the Commission, Suite 316, 1625 I Street, N. W., Washington, D. C. 20006, no later than Friday, May 2, 1980, at 12 noon.

5. That six copies of the financial statements required by Order No. 2086 shall be filed with the Commission and one copy served on any parties of record no later than Friday, April 2, 1980, and the originals shall be produced at the public hearing.

6. That in all other respects, the requirements of Order No. 2086, served February 29, 1980, as it relates to Case No. AP-80-04, remain in effect.
