By Order No. 2094, served March 28, 1980, the Commission granted certain temporary authority to Airport Limo, Inc., subject to compliance with certain conditions.


Inasmuch as Airport Limo has substantially effected compliance and has notified the Commission that it will be ready, willing and able on April 10, 1980, to commence the service for which temporary authority has been granted, further action on this matter is appropriate.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED:

1. That the temporary authority granted to Airport Limo, Inc., by said Order No 2094, shall become effective at 4:00 a.m. on Thursday, April 10, 1980, and shall remain in effect for a period of 180 days until 3:59 a.m. on Tuesday, October 7, 1980, unless otherwise ordered by the Commission.

2. That Airport Limo, Inc., is hereby directed to file an application for a certificate of public convenience and necessity to authorize such operations as are contemplated to be performed for more than 180 days no later than Monday, May 5, 1980, in order to assure sufficient time for the processing thereof.
