Authorization No. SP-18-05 to operate pursuant to WMATC Special Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity No. 1 permits Executive Limousine Service, Inc., to engage in certain charter operations pursuant to two contracts with Trans World Airlines, Inc. (TWA). The authorization is valid until cancelled, and each underlying contract provides that the contract may be cancelled upon 30-days written notice. Executive has on file two tariffs covering these contracts - WMATC Tariff No. 11, filed August 10, 1980, covering the transportation of flight crew members, and WMATC Tariff No. 4, issued June 3, 1975, covering, *inter alia*, transportation of international crew personnel and employees. By notice issued June 25, 1980, and filed with the Commission by Call-A-Messenger, Inc., in Case Nos. CP-80-03 and AP-80-21, official notice of which is hereby taken, TWA cancelled the contract forming the substance of Executive's WMATC Tariff No. 11 effective August 1, 1980. Executive never filed with the Commission any notice that said contract was cancelled, and thus violated Regulation No. 70-05.

On this date, the Commission issued Order No. 2132 granting the above-referenced "CP" application of Call-A-Messenger, Inc., and issuing Authorization No. SP-55-03 covering the operations heretofore performed by Executive under the cancelled contract.

WMATC Special Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity No. 1, set forth in Commission Regulation No. 70-09, includes among its terms, conditions and limitations the following provision:

The authority granted herein terminates automatically, with respect to any contract or contract extension or renewal filed pursuant to Commission Regulation No. 70, when said contract, renewal or extension expires without being extended or renewed in accordance with Regulation No. 70-05 or when the contract, renewal or extension is otherwise cancelled or terminated.


Accordingly, the operations authorized in reliance on the contract incorporated in Executive's WMATC Tariff No. 11 will be deleted from Authorization No. SP-18-05 and a revised Authorization No. SP-18-05 shall be issued.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED:

1. That Authorization No. SP-18-05 issued to Executive Limousine Service, Inc., effective July 23, 1979, is hereby revoked, and that said carrier's WMATC Tariff No 11 is hereby cancelled, all effective on the date of service hereof.

2. That Revised Authorization No. SP-18-05 is hereby issued to Executive Limousine Service., Inc.
