On August 14, 1980, David C. Pearson trading as E & H Transportation Company, filed a motion seeking an extension of time in which to comply with the provisions of Order No. 2114, served May 27, 1980. A previous extension was granted in Order No. 2123, served July 1, 1980. Order No. 2114, granting authority to perform special operations between points in Washington, D. C., and the District of Columbia Department of Corrections facility at Lorton, Va., requires Mr. Pearson to file copies of an appropriate WMATC tariff and notice that his vehicles are available for inspection.


The motion for extension of time requests an additional 30-day period to arrange for the acquisition of two vans needed to provide the authorized service. Previous arrangements for delivery of vehicles did not materialize, necessitating the request. The Commission will grant an extension of 30 days for Mr. Pearson to comply with the provisions of Order No. 2114.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED:

1. That David C. Pearson trading as E & H Transportation Company is hereby granted 30 days from the service date hereof to comply with the provisions of Order No. 2114.

2. That in all other respects, Order No. 2114 remains in full force and effect.
